The best way to find out is to **apply** at dtaconnect.eohhs.mass.gov. There are no risks to applying.

What do I need?

You'll Need	Don't have it?
Identification, e.g. a license or passport	You may be able to use another document. Get help from Project SOUP (listed below).
Social Security Numbers	Only one member of the household needs a social for the household to apply. No social? You may still be eligible. Get help from the places listed below.
Records of income, e.g. paystubs	No income? You can still apply. No income records? Get help from the places listed below.
Records of expenses, e.g. rent, utility, and medical bills	Know how much you pay. Proof is recommended but usually not required.

The DTA will request an interview and documents **after you apply**. Don't have all the information right now? You can apply with only a name and address and the DTA will follow-up for more information.
